PART TWO: THE QUR'AN ON THE DIVINE PURPOSE (continued from Session Five)

CHAPTER SEVEN: "ALLAH, ADAM, AND SHAYTAN: TEST AND TRANSITION":

The most detailed account of the sequence of actions that takes place after Allah has cast Iblis out of *al-jannah*, is given in the following Qur'anic texts: Surah 2: *Al-Baqarah*: 35-39; Surah 7: *Al-A'raf*: 19-25; Surah 20: *Ta-Ha*: 115-123)

CHAPTER EIGHT: "ADAM AND ZAWJ":

In the Qur'an, the words "Adam and *zawj*" are not used to refer to a man and his wife but to all human beings. There is no Qur'anic text which states or suggests that Adam's *zawj* is primarily responsible for the human pair's act of disobedience.

CHAPTER NINE: "THE TREE":

The Qur'an states nothing about the real nature of that "*tree*" beyond pointing out that it was Satan who described it - falsely - as "*the tree of immortality*."

CHAPTER TEN: "ON BECOMING ZALIMIN":

Adam and *zawj* are forewarned by Allah that if they approach "*this one tree*" they will become "*zalimin*" which means wrongdoers" or "evildoers," or "those who wrong themselves."

CHAPTER ELEVEN: "ADAM AND ZAWJ: REPENTANCE AND FORGIVENESS":

Adam and *zawj* acknowledge that they have violated Allah's command. They repent and seek Allah's forgiveness which is

granted to them.
